Attached please find a list of individuals in your PSA who are currently receiving Community Care for Disabled Adults (CCDA) or Home Care for Disabled Adults (HCDA) services and are turning 60 within the next five quarters. Upon turning 60 years of age, individuals in CCDA and HCDA are no longer eligible for these DCF-administered programs.

Please follow the Interagency Agreement included in the *Transitioning Aging Out Clientele Memorandum (081204-1-I-SWCBS)* dated August 9, 2004, and your local procedures to ensure that a consistent protocol is followed for transitioning these individuals. For assistance in managing your Medicaid Waiver budgets, we have also included the names of the Medicaid Waiver clients who are turning 60 during the next four quarters, though the Interagency Agreement does not address Medicaid Waiver clients.
