The purpose of this notice is to transmit the instructions for submitting the Older Americans Act Report for 2005. The instructions are similar to last year. As you are aware, there are some changes to the report. The new caregiver tables (Section I, F and G) count only caregivers receiving Group I services (Counseling/Support Groups/Caregiver Training, Respite Care and Supplemental Services). The completed report must be submitted to the Administration on Aging by January 31, 2006. **In order to meet that deadline, your information must be submitted to the Department by Monday, January 26, 2006.**
