SUBJECT: Notice of Transmittal: SfS Contract Amendment

Department of Elder Affairs (DOEA) Serving Health Insurance Needs of Elders (SHINE) Program has previously awarded funding to each Planning and Service Area (PSA) Area Agency on Aging (AAA) in the amount of \$10,000 for the General Revenue Year 2004-2005. The purpose of this Notice is to announce additional funds from the General Revenue allocation are being made available to each AAA in the amount of \$5,000. These funds will be transferred by issuance of Amendment #001 to Agreement AF004-KF004, Sunshine for Seniors (SfS). These amendments will be forwarded electronically from DOEA in accordance with standard procedures.

The additional funding will be used per the existing work plan. The deliverable date for SfS reports numbers 4 and 5 remain. It is anticipated that due to the current focus on beneficiary education and service related to the Medicare Modernization Act, Public Law 108-173, and the Prescription Discount Card program in every PSA, SfS and SHINE initiatives will be integrated into the Area Plan and promoted/supported by AAA staff.
